## **Payne Offers Quiet Gas Furnaces that Cut Energy Costs**

A slow opening gas valve allows the furnace to start its heating cycle quietly with minimal disturbance to the homeowner. Also, drafts are significantly reduced as the system draws fresh outdoor air into the home.

Original owners can now enjoy their gas furnace even longer when they activate Payne's new 10-year parts limited warranty available if registered within 90 days of purchase. In addition, Payne offers a 20-year limited parts warranty on its heat exchangers.
